Selection/Release of New variety/Genotypes or Techniques development/Recommendation

- 1) The study "standardization of nursery techniques in *Pterocarpus santalinus* (Linn. F.): An endangered tree species" confirms the Redsanders, pods should be treated with 40 per cent HCl for 24 hours to improve germination and 33 g of poultry manure should be applied to improve the initial growth and development of seedlings. These techniques are found to boost the production of quality planting stock of Redsanders.
- 2) The research study "Reproductive biology, molecular profiling and biochemical analysis of *Terminalia chebula* Retz." confirms the need for domestication of *T. chebula* accessions to be based on two ideotypes, one for fruit flesh [Paragpur 1 (G_2)] and the other for seed trait [Paragpur 2 (G_3)].
- 3) Demonstrated low cost water harvesting and soil conservation structures in hilly areas of Nauni-Solan, Himachal Pradesh.
