

ECONOMICAL AND COMFORTABLE COW HOUSING COMPETITION FOR THE DAIRY FARMERS OF GUJARAT

Terms and Conditions

The housing system will be evaluated on the basis of score card developed by these experts.

Broad points which will be considered for this event will be as

- The competition is open for the farmers located in Gujarat having 05-50 cow holding.
- The farmer should rear the cows untied at least for major part of the day and feeding and water arrangements must be accessible as per need of the cows.
- Farms constructed on contract with heavy usage of steel and cement will not be eligible.
- Judging Committee will put emphasis on use of local resources and farmer participation in designing.
- The farmers should send at least four images of the farm taken from different angles. The picture should be clear and should show the floor, roof and the cows housed in it.
- One photo should be a long shot covering the entire farm premises.
- The selected participants will be contacted by the judging committee to collect additional information on the farm, it is mandatory to provide replies on video-call.
- The images submitted by the farmers may be used in publications. In all such cases, the use will be non-commercial and due acknowledgement to the farmer will be given.
- The right to reject any entry will remain with the judging committee and no representation against their decision will be accepted.
- Each farmer can submit only one entry.
- The Milk Union / dairy processors / dairy cooperatives / KVKs and other service providers can submit as many entries, but in each case, they should give details of the farmers, such as name, address and contact number.

Implementation

- ❖ Farmers have to provide following details before uploading their farm images on our WhatsApp account
 - Name of the Farmer

- Complete postal address (Farther`s name, village/town, locality, taluka, district, Pin code, mobile number having WhatsApp account, email address)
- Social category
- Caste
- Total number of cows at their farm
- Approximate farm area
- Approximate cost incurred in constructing farm

Score card

Following points will be considered while judging cow housing

1. Area per cow (10 marks)
2. Cost of construction per cow (15 marks)
3. Percent of open area (15 marks)
4. Floor type (15 marks)
5. Shed type (10 marks)
6. Use of local resources (15 marks)
7. Design novelty (10 marks)
8. Overall design (10 marks)
