NAHEP-CAAST

Centres for Advanced Agricultural Science and Technology (CAAST) is a new initiative and student centric sub-component of "National Agricultural Higher Education Project (NAHEP)" implemented by Indian Council of Agricultural Research and funded by Government of India as well as World Bank on 50:50 basis. The Navsari Agricultural University, Navsari, Gujarat bagged a CAAST project entitled "Establishment of Secondary Agriculture Unit for Skill development in Students and Farmers" on competitive basis in 2017-18. Presently, there is a great demand for wooden articles to decorate houses, corporate and government offices/ institutions for serenity of expression. As there is excellent scope for entrepreneurship in this field, it was felt necessary to organize a Hands-On training in "Wooden Decoratives" at NAU, Navsari.

BACKGROUND

Wooden Decoratives

Wooden Decoratives are made through hand and or machine works on wood as well as waste wooden samples. Woodworking is the activity as well as skill of making decorative items from wooden materials. Woodwork Industry is one of the fastest growing industries in India's economy. India has about 100,000 registered wood ware units and more than 200,000 artisans along with countless other woodworking related units. Wood has always been a major part of Indian handicrafts and various beautiful things are crafted out of it. India takes pride in manufacturing exquisite and handsome wooden handicrafts in diverse motifs. In the rural areas of India, furniture and other household utensils are carved out of wood in different shapes and styles. These simple objects are so uniquely blend that they in no way look like daily use stuffs. Animal figures are also an excellent example of India's ethnic woodwork. Wooden decorates also include toys, wall hangers, tree sculptures, mantpa, key hangers, stemp decorates, pen stands, wooden corner decorates, tree machanas, etc. Wooden decoratives are generally made using solid stock from hardwoods due to its strength and resistance to warping. Apart from wood, bamboo is also widely used for preparation of articles and decorative.

Secondary Agriculture is often regarded as the sunrise sector of Indian economy owing to its immense untapped potential. Secondary Agriculture sector has a major role to play in employment generation, poverty alleviation and

product diversification including waste wood utilization. Preparation of wooden decorates is one of the ways to improve the earnings and standard of living of farmers, forest dweller's and tribal's. The Government of India and Indian Council of Agricultural Research has also emphasized the importance of Hands-On training to the students of agriculture and allied fields for expansion of entrepreneurship in the country. In this context, CAAST-NAU is organizing three days Hands-On training on "Wooden Decoratives" at NAU, Navsari from July 24-26, 2019.

OBJECTIVES

- To provide Hands-On training to PG students regarding preparation of wooden decorates including bamboo articles

COURSE CONTENT

This training will broadly cover diverse topics related to preparation of wooden decorative viz.,

- 1) Learning about different hardwood and softwood species used in wooden decorative
- 2) Hands on training to participants in different aspects of wooden decorative utilizing In-House expertise
- 3) Involvement of local successful artisans for preparation of wooden decorative and bamboo articles and their interaction with trainees
- 4) To invoke participants skills in preparation of wooden decorative and hold competition among the trainees

DURATION

This is a 3 days residential Hands-On training programme which includes Interactive Lectures, Hands-On training, Demonstrations and Competition among trainees in the preparation of wooden decorates.

ELIGIBILITY

Currently enrolled Post graduates from Agriculture /Forestry/Veterinary Sciences/Horticulture faculties of Navsari Agricultural University are eligible for this training program. The candidate should have scored at least 60% marks in any of the above degrees. There are 25 seats available in this training which would be distributed as under:
